DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Le Rouet is the picturesque cove on the Blue Coast that gives its name to this elegant, Organic Provence rosé. Planted near the famous Sainte Victoire hill, painted by Paul Cézanne, on the limestone soils of Aix-en-Provence. The grapes are harvested with minimal intervention, no destemming followed by immediate fermentation at a very cool temperature to preserve the freshness, primary aromatics and complexity. No malolactic fermentation to keep freshness and acidity. La Dame du Rouet is then refined in stainless steel tanks for three to five months at low temperatures before bottling with minimal fining.

TASTING NOTES

Beautiful rose petal pink. Delicate nose. Fresh fruit aromas with a touch of spice. Palate: Subtle yet crisp with a beautiful complexity. This wine is full of finesse, with notes of redcurrants and raspberries, but also some garrigue (scrubland) aromas of rosemary, thyme and fennel.

HOW TO SERVE

A rosé for gourmets, to be enjoyed with delicate food such as a guinea fowl, sea bream, sea bass or just shared in good company. Serve chilled at 12°C
