DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Chanson is one of the major owners of Clos des Mouches with a vineyard of 4.5 hectares. Clos de Mouche has a sunny Terroir which benefits from an ideal location on the hill at the southern end of the vineyards of Beaune on a spur pointing toward Pommard. A plot of 2 hectares on the upper side of the hill is planted with Chardonnay on stony soils of limestone (subsoil), clay and silica. After a very cold winter and a demanding spring in 2011, the hot summer was regularly interrupted by rainy intervals. It gave way early september to a bright and warm weather, that speeded up the maturation of the grapes. Harvest began in the last days of September under a bright sunshine. Meticulous vinifications and aging in oak for 14 months have enabled us to tame the vibrant acidity of the white wines.

TASTING NOTES

Pale gold color. Intense citrus fruit aromas mixed with fresh butter notes and spices on a hint of minerality. Generous with a good volume. Opulent with an onctuous texture. Well-shaped acidity. Persistent and mineral aftertaste.

HOW TO SERVE

To be enjoyed with seafood and goat's cheese.

“93/100. Ripe and rich, this full-bodied wine retains minerality as well as attractive acidity. Crisp lemon flavor is rounded out with peach and apple skin fruits. The wood, already integrated, gives richness and smoothness. Drink from 2016.”
