# CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE VILLAGES SIGNARGUES



## DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Recognition of the “Villages” wines was acquired in stages from 1953 to 1979. These ruralities, numbering 74, bearing characteristics worthy of generating original qualities in their wines were superior to the regional appellation standard.

The vineyards used harbour clay and limestone soils coming from terraces of round pebbles and lauzes rock made of limestone. Grapes are harvested at maturity. Vat times are performed in concrete vats from 3 to 4 weeks with daily pumping over. The wine is aged for one year in concrete vats.

## TASTING NOTES

Dark garnet-red colour with aromas of very ripe black fruits. Spicy and liquorice come through on the palate.
