SAUMUR ROUGE

DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

In 1982, Bernard Leroux produced the first vintage of the wine which was to be the Domaine Langlois-Chateau red and white. Since then, and as a result of the success that it has had, Langlois-Chateau has increased its vineyard holding in the Saumur area and consistently increased the quality of the wines. This wine is produced with fruit from the Coudray-Macouard and St-Florent vineyards (total of 20 hectares). Following the harvest the grapes were totally destemmed and maceration took place for 15 days in stainless steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

A leafy, fresh example of Cabernet Franc that is cherry red color with purple hints. An open nose with notes of cassis and raspberry. On the palate, a supple start develops into noticeable but round tannins with powerful red fruit flavours. Well balanced.

HOW TO SERVE

Delightful in the prime of its youth, but particularly appreciated after a few months of ageing. Serve with grilled white meats, charcuterie and soft cheeses.
