Fly Away to Cognac Blues Passions in Jarnac!

Lenny Kravitz was the headline act at this year's Cognac Blues Passions in Jarnac; the festival of Afro-American music sponsored by all the Cognac houses in the region, including our very own Delamain! Visitors also enjoyed music from Charlie Winston, Katie Melua and Otis Clay during the five day blues-fest.

Amongst the crowd were customers of Mentzendorff and the 2014 winner of the WSET Delamain Scholarship who the highest mark in the Spirits exam of the WSET diploma. Between the acts, there was a behind the scenes look at the home of Delamain Cognac, which dates from 1759. Still owned by descendants of the original founder James Delamain, the House's objective is simple; remain faithful to tradition and offer Cognacs of the purest, most genuine expression. Tradition also combines with innovation at Delamain; they were the first house to release vintage Cognacs, with many others since following suit.
